 - Heman, son of Samuel (1 Ch 6:33), son of Korah (6:37)
 - 15:12-13 Importance of careful, God-pleasing worship
 - 15:22 Chenaniah led because he understood
- 1 Chron 16:7-36 First organized psalm service
 - v8-22 = Psalm 105:1-15
 - v23-33 = Psalm 96:1-13a (v34 used frequently)
 - v35-36 = Ps 106:47-48
 - 16:37,41 Ethan apparently renamed Jeduthun (Ps 39,62,77)
- 1 Chron 25:1,7 Prophesied in song (teaching), trained, skillful

THOUGHTFUL WORSHIP

- 1 Chron 16:7ff Thoughtful preparation:
 - Worship must not be random, but thoughtful
 - Worship must not be centered on my preferences
 - Worship is more effective when all come prepared
- 1 Chron 15:22; 25:7 Thoughtful leadership:
 - Understanding music helps song worship
 - To glorify God, not to glorify self/song
 - To edify others, not to put on a show
 - To teach, to admonish, to let the Word dwell within us
