Question 15: In 4:1, Paul now turns his attention to walking in a worthy manner. Why might this message be necessary for Gentiles in particular?

Question 16: As a result of Christ's victory and ascension, what has He given to man (4:8)?

Question 17: Why are the other Gentiles excluded from the life of God (4:18-19)?

Question 18: How do you think someone can grieve the Holy Spirit (4:30)?

Question 19: What type of person is equated with an idolater and why do you think this is (5:5)?

Question 20: What is contrasted with being filled with the Spirit in 5:18? Why would this be incompatible with being filled with the Spirit?

Question 21: Ephesians 5:22-33 gives instructions regarding wives and husbands, and how they ought to act towards one another. What responsibilities does the wife have toward her husband? Likewise, what are the responsibilities of the husband toward his wife?

Question 22: Who do we fight against, and how do they fight against us (6:12)?

Ouestion 23: In describing the armor of God, Paul borrows language from Isaiah, particularly the breastplate of righteousness and the helmet of salvation referencing Isaiah 59:17. In Isaiah 59, who is the one wearing this armor?

Question 24: What do we know about Tychicus and what role did he play with this epistle?
